



BROMYARD GALA SOCIETY LTD  
SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS

- 1 The Society reserves the right at all times to refuse admission to any trade stand, exhibitor or his staff.
- 2 Admittance to the showground will be strictly on a pre-payment basis. Entry will be refused if this condition is not complied with.
- 3 All admission of traders and their staff will be by exhibitor's passes
- 4 Acceptance by the Society of a firm reservation or pre-payment of rental in no way confers any rights whatsoever to the renting trader and in no way modifies these conditions
- 5 Refunds and payments in respect of cancellation of reservations will be reviewed upon merits of each case.
- 6 The site must be left in a clean and tidy condition. All refuse must be placed in the bins provided.
- 7 Mock auctions by any trader will not be permitted. Traders in breach of this condition will be expelled from the showground.
- 8 Games of chance are not permitted unless written permission has been given in advance
- 9 All traders must ensure that they have adequate insurance and will absolve the Society from any such legal liability
- 10 All traders must ensure that they have adequate fire-fighting equipment available
- 11 No sub-letting of the allocated site is permitted
- 12 Traders must only sell items specified on their booking form.
- 13 The use of a PA system is not permitted
- 14 All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and be under proper control
- 15 All generators used by traders for whatever purpose must be quiet and not produce foul exhaust omissions. They must have a current inspection certificate.
- 16 The allocation of sites and positioning of trade space will be entirely at the discretion of the Society, although every endeavour will be made to meet any special requests of trade exhibitors.
  - (a) Traders must ensure that they book and pay for sufficient space for all stays, guy ropes or hitch for any building, tent or caravan to occupy the site.
  - (b) Boundaries of sites will be marked and each site numbered. Under no circumstances will a trader be allowed to occupy a larger space than that allocated to him.
  - (c) The Society will not be held responsible for damage caused to sites during the pre-show period by any means, including adverse weather conditions and does not undertake to make good any such damage.
  - (d) Traders and their staff must confine their sales activities to the area of their stand and must not use the avenues to solicit business.
- 17 Traders' cars and those of their staff not forming part of the exhibit must be parked in the area designated by the Society.
- 18 Vehicle movements are not permitted during the main show hours and should be off the showground by 10.30am each day.
- 19 All trade stand exhibitors must follow instructions issued by the Society or their designated representatives.
- 20 In all matters of dispute the Societies decision will be final.
