You are cordially invited to submit an oil engine entry in the **43rd Bromyard Gala, to be held on 3rd and 4th July 2010**. If you wish to come, please complete this form and send it to **Roger Wilkins, Chanctonbury, Pencombe Road, Bromyard, Herefordshire, HR7 4SS**, together with **TWO stamped, addressed envelopes, for passes and entry forms for next year, by 21<sup>st</sup> March**. (My telephone numbers are 01885 488206 or mobile 07801 063495).

Please excuse the formality of this form, the reasons for which I know you will understand. Following on from the concerns expressed at the NTET Rally Organisers' Conference about rallies generally, and Health and Safety concerns over vehicle movements on our field, we have to insist that entries and vehicles are not moved until after 5 pm each day, unless the show is formally abandoned and the section steward tells you. Please do not enter if you cannot agree to this. Our section is actually not the real problem here – for which thank you all! – but all sections will have a three-line whip on this one.

Brief history details for insertion in programme:

I declare that during the Event

a. Any self propelled exhibit will be covered by the minimum insurance requirement as required by the Road Traffic Act if my exhibit is not excluded from use on the public highway, irrespective of whether it is licensed or not.  
 b. If my exhibit is not self propelled it will be covered by a Public Liability policy having a limit of indemnity of not less than £5,000,000, in any one accident. You will be able to produce documentary evidence that such cover is in force before setting up your exhibit. If you have any queries on this matter, please contact the safety officer who is Ian Briggs, Green Cottage, Green Lane, Bromyard, HR7 4RZ.

- I further declare that the driver/ rider of any exhibit not excluded from use on the public highway holds a driving licence of the appropriate class for that exhibit, and that no person will drive **any** vehicle on the showground unless that person holds a valid driving licence for that vehicle.
- I agree to produce the insurance and licence documents to the Event Organiser or Safety Officer when requested.
- I agree to produce, on request, an Inspection certificate in accordance with the IEE Regulations for any electrical equipment (i.e., generators, wiring, appliances).
- I agree to abide by the Code of Practice of the National Traction Engine Trust and the Society's written Statement of Safety Policy.
- I agree to operate my exhibit during the Event and comply with the instructions of stewards.
- In the event of a dispute the Event Organisers decision is final.
- My entry will be in full working order and, in the case of oil engines, will be shown in operation for a substantial period of each day, and that anyone in attendance will be (a) fully conversant with the method of operation and control of the exhibit, and (b) not under 14 years of age.
- **I confirm that my exhibit will not be removed, or vehicles moved on the field, before 5 p.m. each day, and my exhibit will be in position by 10 a.m. each day. If you cannot comply with these requirements you must not enter.**
